Couch to 2K - Fun Run

Maths Tips for Parents/Guardians

As referenced in our last newsletter, the focus of our current School Improvement Plan is 'Emphasising Mathematical Modelling'. 'How' children learn is as important as 'what' children learn. Mathematical modelling involves children using Mathematics to describe a problem-context and determine meaningful solutions to the problem. This month, we continue to share some practical tips for parents / guardians on how you can support your child's learning at home.

1. Never share the idea with your children that you were bad at Maths in school or you dislike it. Research has shown that as soon as parents do this, their children's attainment and achievement in Maths went down.
2. Parents / Guardians can encourage real-life Maths by integrating it into daily routines like cooking (measuring), shopping (comparing prices), and travel (estimating time/distance), while fostering a positive mindset by praising effort, not just answers, to show the everyday relevance of Maths and build confidence. We recently discovered that many of our pupils are big darts fans! Darts is a fun and engaging way to practise our mental arithmetic!

Grandparents' Day

We celebrated Grandparents' Day recently with our Junior Infants and 6th Class pupils welcoming their grandparents to the school. We gathered in the church for a short prayer service where we especially remembered those grandparents who were unable to attend on the day. The children had great fun showing our guests around the school and we must also thank our wonderful Parents' Association for providing the refreshments in the hall. Please ensure to check your child's waste box each day and to make changes to their choices on the app if required. We will remind you also that parents / guardians can cancel lunches on days when you know your child won't be in school, or if there isn't a choice to their satisfaction. Instructions below;

1. Open the app.
2. In the top left hand corner you'll see 3 lines. Click this and then choose calendar.
3. You can flick between children if you've more than one child in the school.
4. Click on the dates you want to cancel the meals.

A short demonstration video is available to view on the school website. Remember, all orders or changes to orders must be completed at least 48 hours in advance. Hopefully this will reduce food waste going forward.
