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# **Covid-19 Update**

As you are aware by now, the government have lifted almost all remaining restrictions relating to Covid-19. The Department of Education has advised that schools can now begin to revert to normal routines. This means that the wearing of face masks and the requirement to maintain classroom pods and bubbles is now gone.

As stated in a recent communication, although masks are no longer mandatory, some pupils and staff members may still choose to wear them. This personal choice will be completely respected. It is also still advised to wear face masks on school buses. Now that restrictions are lifted, we look forward to resuming activities such as matches, swimming lessons, mentoring and school tours.

The guidelines with respect to symptoms have not changed however. If your child displays any symptoms of Covid-19, they cannot attend school. Please continue to check the HSE website for the most up-to-date advise.

# **Internet Safety**

We recently marked Internet Safety Day in the school with activities and lessons in each classroom. These lessons coincided with the parental webinar that evening run by Barnardos. Our Student Council also conducted a survey with all the pupils from 2nd Class to 6th Class. Some of the findings were expected, but some of them below also surprised us;

- 19% of pupils surveyed spend more than 3 hours online each day.
- 26% of pupils say their parents have no rules with regard to internet usage.
- Only 61% of pupils feel safe using the internet.

What was probably most alarming was the number of children, even as far down as 3rd and 4th Class, who said they have their own mobile smart phones.
