Healthy Eating Policy

We are currently in the process of reviewing our school's Healthy Eating Policy. The aim of the policy is to help us develop an environment that is conducive to promoting healthy eating choices in our school. We will circulate our draft policy in the coming days and we would greatly welcome some feedback on this.

Each child in the school recently completed an online survey using the school iPads as part of this process. You might like to note some of the results below:

- 71.2% of children bring water to school each day.
- 73% eat a sandwich, wrap or roll each day.
- 70.3% brought some fruit to school that day.
- 29.1% of pupils reported that they make their own school lunch.
- 90.4% of pupils believe that the school should have a healthy eating policy.
