Enrolment for the Junior Infant Class 2024/2025 opens today, January 8th, and will remain open until January 31st. Please inform any family members or neighbours if they've children ready to start school in September. We also have some capacity in other classes. Enrolment forms are available from the school office or can be downloaded from the school website www.rathns.ie. Our Admissions Policy is also online. It is important that all prospective parents read the policy carefully beforehand.

To coincide with our enrolment process, the school will host an Open Day on Saturday January 13th between 11am and 1pm. It will give children and parents an opportunity to visit the school and speak with some of our staff and pupils.

Parking

You should have received a letter from the board of management recently with regard to parking outside the school. To remind you, concerns have been expressed lately about some dangerous practices and the following requests have been made by the board of management, as the body responsible for health & safety:

- Please reverse into the spaces provided at the school wall. Reversing on to the road is quite dangerous.
- Please collect your child from the gate and escort them to your car. Children should not be left to walk across such a busy road unaccompanied.
- We ask you not to U-turn outside the school or playschool. Please use the church car park or the junction at the pump to turn around if necessary.
- There are lots of car parking spaces at the church. Please consider using the footpath inside the ditch. However, children will need to be accompanied from the gate at the end of the path to the car park.
- If you plan to stay and chat with others, please use parking spaces away from the school wall.

Cllr. PJ Kelly has also been engaging with Laois County Council with regard to putting safety measures in place and we will work with him on this matter. Please pass on this information to other adults responsible for collecting your children from school.
